

BUCKET RHYTHM BINGO

BINGO SHEETS

To keep bingo sheets reusable, you can print out a blank sheet and cut out the squares. You could also use pennies, construction paper or candy to cover bingo matches.

SHEET MUSIC

Use with any of the "ear training" sheet music located in the members area.
Bucketdrumming.net/getting-started/ear-training

Either print out individual sheet music for students to refer to or show on an overhead projector (or smartboard).

DIRECTIONS

-Print "DRUM" bingo letters cut them out. Put them in a hat or basket to draw from.

-Print which ever Copy Cat Level you will be playing from. Cut out individual measures. Put them in a hat or basket to draw from.

-Draw one of each (DRUM letter & Copy Cat measure).

-2 ways to play- "Visual Matching" or "Matching By Ear"

Visual Matching

Write out that measure or show them the rhythm on the smartboard to find the corresponding measure.

Matching By Ear

Play that measure and students will find matching measure.

Students then mark down the matching measure number on their bingo sheet.

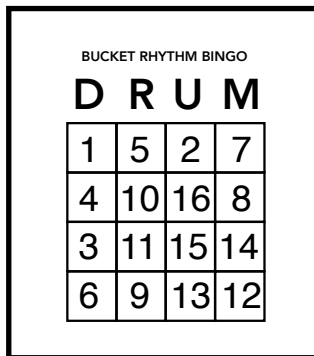
Bonus points for students after getting a bingo to play all the rhythms back that were matched correctly.

30 Different Bingo Sheets

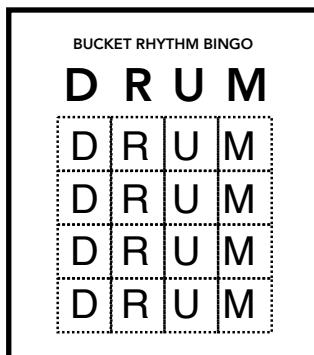


10 Different Rhythm Levels

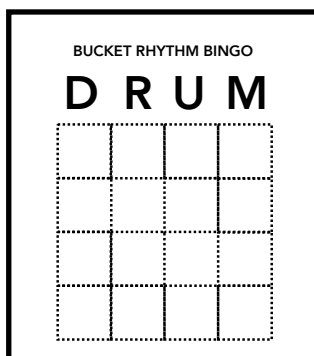
In Members Area
